| At the CFT Part-time Faculty Committee meeting, discussions took place around training for Distance Learning and evaluations. Resolutions for the Convention were approved on Distance Learning Training and Pay for that training. |

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102. Jason said he'd been working with locals to get their delegate situation ironed out for convention.

103. There's a lot going on with the budget which is looking more positive than was earlier projected.

104. Some agreements have been outlined around K-12, but not community colleges. Gavin New-

105. some is being assaulted by the Republican recall effort. CFT is going to be doing what it can to
 106 assure that no democrats join in the effort as alternative candidates.

107. As to the current grievance, he said the next step would need strong circumstantial evidence of

108. a long pattern of improper scheduling. He thought it would be difficult tomake progress within

109. management's ability to get around the contract language. He wants to see strengthening of the

110. contract language for clarity of determining availability for assignments in future negotiations. We 111. just hit stage 3 in this process. The next is non-binding arbitration. Jason considers this a waste

112. of up to \$10,000. He volunteered meeting with the member to convey the uphill nature of the

113. battle ahead in spite of the righteous nature of her complaint. The local could be damaged by

114. losing the arbitration and a win could still be ignored by the district. Seniority lists are not being

115. provided by the District, which should be a straight forward process.
